**ORDER ON DEFENDANTS MICHAEL SHAH AND ZILMIL, INC.'S (1) UNOPPOSED  
MOTION TO CONTINUE PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION HEARING AND  
CORRESPONDING EXTENSION OF STATUTORY RESTRAINING ORDER AND  
OTHER EMERGENCY RELIEF; AND (2) UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR  
ENLARGEMENT OF RESPONSE DEADLINE TO COMPLAINT**


This cause came to be considered on Defendants Dr. Michael Shah and Zilmil, Inc.'s: Unopposed Motion to Continue Preliminary Injunction Hearing and Corresponding Extension of Statutory Restraining Order and Other Emergency Relief; and (2) Unopposed Motion for Enlargement of Time to Respond to Complaint (the "Unopposed Motion") (Doc. 25), and the Court having reviewed the Unopposed Motion and otherwise being fully advised in the premises, the Court finds that the parties have shown good cause for a continuance of the show cause hearing and corresponding extension of the SRO Order in order to preserve the temporary injunction and asset freeze. The Defendants have requested the continuance to a date no earlier than August 10, 2017, pursuant to Rule 65(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and Plaintiff Commodity Futures Trading Commission has indicated it is unopposed to this request. Defendants have also requested an enlargement of the time for Defendants to respond to the Complaint (Doc. 3) from

August 4, 2017 to August 24, 2017. The Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises, accordingly,

**ORDERS AND ADJUDGES** that:

1. The Unopposed Motion (Doc. 25) is **GRANTED**;
2. The show cause hearing previously scheduled for July 26, 2017 is continued to **August 10, 2017, at 12:00 p.m.** (Courtroom 10D, United States Courthouse, 300 North Hogan Street, Jacksonville, Florida)<sup>1</sup>; the Court's July 12, 2017 SRO Order (Doc. 8) and the July 19, 2017 Supplemental Order (Doc. 21) shall be extended in all aspects until the conclusion and the Court's resolution of the show cause hearing, or until further Order of this Court; Defendants' responses to the Statutory Restraining Order Motion (Doc. 5) shall be filed no later than **August 8, 2017 at 12:00 p.m.**; and
3. Defendants shall file their response to the Complaint on or before **August 24, 2017**.
